
SUBJECT: DECISION ON INITIAL ENVIRONMENTAL EXAMINATION (IEE).

1. Name & Address of Proponent: Muhammad Haroon Memon, Chief Operating Officer, House No. G-213, Citizen Society, Hyderabad.
2. Description of Project: Storage of LPG and filling in cylinders.
3. Location of Project: M/s. Ali-Akbar Energy (Pvt.) Limited, Survey No. 513/4 & 514/4, Deh Miano, Tapo Hatri, Hyderabad, Sindh.
4. Date of Filing of IEE: 07-08-2020.
5. After careful review of the Initial Environmental Examination, Sindh Environmental Protection Agency (SEPA), accords its approval subject to the following conditions: -
 - i) All mitigation measures recommended in IEE report must be complied with, for achieving negligible impacts on physical, biological, environmental and socio-economic resources of the area.
 - ii) That the Sindh Environmental Quality Standards (SEQS) for ambient air quality, noise, industrial emissions, wastewater and drinking water shall be followed in letter and spirit.
 - iii) That the Mitigation measures recommended in the IEE report must be strictly adhered to minimize any adverse impact on soil, ambient air quality, biological resources and marine ecosystem in the project area. The proponent shall comply with Sindh Environmental Quality Standards (SEQS) during construction and operational activities of the project.
 - iv) That the complete code of Health, Safety and Environment (HSE) shall be developed, which should include efficient parameters at specific work plan for this purpose HES setup should be established and supervised by a designated HSE officer at the senior level with sufficient administrative and technical authority to perform the designated functions. Proponent will make sure that the operating instructions and emergency actions are made available to every worker / labor / commuter at the site.
 - v) That the Independent Monitoring Consultant (IMC) shall be engaged by management to monitor the implementation of Environmental Management Plan (EMP) during construction and operation phase of the project and proponent will submit report to Sindh EPA on Quarterly basis w.e.f. issuance of this approval.
 - vi) That the M/s. Ali-Akbar Energy (Pvt.) Limited shall ensure state of the art and international standards for safety of the oil storage terminal to prevent any safety related hazard. In case of any unfortunate incident of leakage, fire and leading disaster the proponent will be responsible for compensation to any affected people and also for damage caused to environment and natural resources. To cope with the hazard emergency response, contingency plan should be developed prior to operational phase of the project.

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- vii) That the discharging and dumping of any kind of waste material into harbor waters will not be allowed international maritime standards for disposal of waste shall be followed in letter and spirit.
- viii) That the effective solid waste management system will be developed which would cater to collection, transfer, recycling and final disposal of waste to a designated landfill site. The plan must address on site segregation of solid waste to promote its reuse and recycling. The oily sludge shall be disposed of in accordance to best available practices through SEPA approved contactor.
- ix) That the all unskilled jobs will be provided to the local people, skilled jobs will also be offered to local people after providing proper training.
6. That the approval shall be treated as null and void if the conditions mentioned in this approval are not complied with or any violation of SEP Act, Rules, Regulations Guidelines and instructions is observed by this office.
7. That the proponent shall be liable for compliance of Section 14, 15, 18 and 19 of EIA / IEE Regulations, 2014 which direct for condition for approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspection and monitoring.
8. That this approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or consent that may be required under any law in force.
9. That this approval is not valid for any Court matter / dispute.
10. That the no violation of any regulations, rules, instruction and provision of SEP Act-2014, shall be made and in case of any such violation of the rules / laws in the approval shall stand considered as cancelled without any further notice.
11. That the Sindh EPA at any stage of the project reserve the right to issue instructions for any independent audit or impose any condition to ensure that the project is being constructed under strict compliance of Environmental legislation and conditions of this approval.
12. That this approval is accorded only for the proposed project activity described in the IEE report. Proponent shall submit separate EIA or IEE as required under regulations for any enhancement or major change in the design of proposed project.
